- 27. Pinot Grigio Rose Montevento, Italy** £16.50
A fresh, well balanced and fruity wine with elegant, floral notes and hints of pear and apricot.
- 28. La Brouette Rose, France** £17.50
Local growers in Gascony to produce high quality wines. A blend of several local grape varieties, this rose offers layers of fruity fresh strawberries and cream with supple tannins and lively acidity.
- 29. Source Gabriel Rosé AOC Cotes de Provence** £27.00
This is classic Provence rosé. So pale and delicate yet fruity it's a real crowd-pleaser. Floral notes coupled with that kind of rich stone fruit you only get from wines from this part of France.

- 30. Veuve Clicquot, Champagne** £50.00
With a label recognisable at twenty paces, this is a Champagne house that produces 25 million bottles per year! Blended of the three classic Champagne grapes - Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier - this combines richness and elegance, with citrus fruits and real freshness.
- 31. Guy de Chasse Grand Cru Brut NV, Champagne** £39.00
The De Chasse family house is located in the village of Louvois which has 100% Grand Cru status. Hand-made at every step from a tiny 11 hectares of vines, this finely structured blend has a bit of everything: zesty apple and citrus fruit, balanced by richer, toasted brioche flavours.
- 32. Sylvos Prosecco DOC Treviso Le Colture Brut** £22.95
Beautifully made Prosecco that seriously overdelivers from boutique winery 'Le Colture' in the heart of Valdobbiadene.

- 33. Corney and Barrow Ruby Port** £4.50
Quality ruby port, intensely coloured, rich and peppery. Matured for three years in seasoned oak it provides perfect drinking right now.
- 34. San Emilio Pedro Ximenez Solera Reserva Emilio Lustau** £4.95
This Pedro Ximenez shows luscious notes of dried figs, chocolate, caramel and coffee. Try over vanilla ice cream as the locals do for an extra special treat!
- 35. Chateau Septy, Monbazillac, France** £3.95
Château Septy is located on the hills and plateau of Pomport. The average age of the vines is over 40 years old. Using just Semillon & Muscadelle grapes whose vines is over 40 years old. Picked when over-ripe after successive passages through the vineyard. Honey and ripe fruit flavours with a fine, structured palate.

01. La Brouette Blanc, France Fresh clean classic blend from the Gascony area with the peach, citrusy characters of Colombard and the natural regional acidity making it a perfectly balanced.	£15.50
02. Il Carretto Bianco di Puglia, Italy Made from Malvasia grapes,. Its zesty aromas and almondy notes make it a very versatile wine.	£16.50

09. Lofthouse Sauvignon Blanc, New Zealand Situated right next door to Cloudy Bay this is Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc at its best - grassy, fresh and invigorating, rather too easy to drink!	£26.00
10. Macon-Solutre Maison Auvigue, Burgundy The Auvigue family own several exceptional vineyards around the famous rock of Solutre. Their Macon-Solutre is creamy and round with ripe orchard fruit, balanced by an elegant freshness.	£29.00
11. Chablis Vincent Dampt 2013, Burgundy Benchmark Chablis from rising star Vincent Dampt - stony minerality and richness with perfect poise.	£29.00
12. Gruner Veltliner Loss Weingut Jurtschitsch, Austria Certified organic since 2009 this wine displays aromas of green apple, peach and pineapple. The löss soils - impart a saline minerality with a punch of white pepper. This wine can be enjoyed with a vast array of dishes.	£33.00
