Pinot Grigio Blush, Folonari £16.95
Italy, 12% 250ml £6.00
175ml £4.50
Crisp and clean with summer fruit flavours and a style which is on the sweeter side of dry.

White Zinfandel, Waters Edge £16.95
USA, 10% 250ml £6.00

A sweeter style rose, this White Zinfandel is jam packed with ripe strawberry and raspberry flavours.

Prosecco, Millevini £22.95
Italy, 12% 200ml £6.95
This Prosecco is full of ripe citrus notes; the fresh lemon and grapefruit hitting the senses next to the refreshing bite of green apple. Refreshing, clean and immensely enjoyable.

Champagnes

Gruet Brut NV £29.95
France, 12%
This Champagne is full bodied and powerful with exquisite fruit aromas.

Mumm Cordon Rouge NV £59.95
France, 12%
Fresh, fruity and elegant this is the perfect drink for celebrating. This is a Champagne to be enjoyed as an aperitif or with food and its aromatic richness is also a perfect match for white meat and fish.

Dessert Wines

Orange Muscat & Flora, Brown Bros. £16.95
Australia, 10% 37.5cl Bottle
Aromas of orange blossom, fresh citrus and spice, with a textured and rich palate, a crisp acidity balances the sweetness of the palate and leads on in a zesty finish.

Muscat de Beaumes de Venise £16.95
France, 15.5% 37.5cl Bottle
Golden yellow in colour and a powerful, rich and elegant nose of candied fruits and flowers. A well-balanced palate with a great length and good, steady aromatic persistence.



Wine List

White Wines

Pinot Grigio, Folonari £16.95

Italy, 11.5% 250ml £6.00

175ml £4.50
A dry and light wine with zesty citrus fruit flavours combining flavours of white pear, honey and green apple. Fresh with a tongue tingling acidity.

Sauvignon Blanc, Tolva £16.95

Chile, 12% 250ml £6.00

175ml £4.50
Crisp, herbaceous, clean and well balanced. Elegant aromas with dominant notes of flowers mixed with herbal tones.

Chardonnay, Concha y Toro £16.95

Chile, 13% 250ml £6.00

175ml £4.50
A crisp, fresh Chardonnay, bursting with peach and citrus fruit flavours. Great to drink on its own or with fish, chicken or pasta with a creamy sauce.

Chenin Blanc, Butterfly Tree £17.95

South Africa, 12.5%

A wonderfully lively wine, packed with exotic fruit, citrus flavours and a subtle herby character.

Rioja Blanco, El Coto £19.95

Spain, 12%

The Rioja region, although perhaps better known for its reds, also makes notable white wines. This is a modern, un-oaked, fresh expression of white Rioja made from the Viura grape.

Sauvignon Blanc, Saint Clair £25.95

New Zealand, 13%

Considered one of the best Marlborough Sauvignon Blancs. Expect lots of Passion fruit, gooseberry and blackcurrant leaf flavours with crisp but refreshing acidity, a lovely mouth-feel and finish.

Pouilly-Fuisse, Domaine Quinson £34.95

France, 12.5%

Fresh and full flavoured, this white wine is loaded with aromas and tasting notes of hazelnuts, almond, grapefruit and wonderful fresh lemon.

Red Wines

Merlot, Tolva £16.95

Chile, 12.5% 250ml £6.00

175ml £4.50
This wine has aromas of ripe black fruit, cherry and mulberry. Fruity, smooth and medium-bodied.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Concha y Toro £16.95

Chile, 13.5% 250ml £6.00

175ml £4.50
Aromas of berries, cassis and chocolate notes with a hint of plum and vanilla. Full-bodied with smooth, rich berry and cassis flavours.

Shiraz, Silver Creek £16.95

Australia, 14% 250ml £6.00

175ml £4.50
With flavours of plums, blackberries and spice, this Shiraz is enhanced on the palate by vanilla, dark chocolate and spicy pepper tones.

Tempranillo, Sonsierra £17.95

Spain, 13.5%

Deep ruby red, 100% Tempranillo from Rioja Alta. Ripe cherry fruit, vanilla & blackcurrant nose with strong fruit flavours.

Malbec, Tribu Trivento £19.95

Argentina, 12%

A classic Argentinian Malbec, a clean nose with aromas of red fruit gives way to a well rounded palate with blackberry and raspberry flavours and a touch of vanilla.

Pinot Noir, Saint Clair £25.95

New Zealand, 13.5%

This is a fantastic New Zealand Pinot Noir, fruit driven and inviting. An easy and ready to drink style. Dark berry, cola and black cherry flavours are rich and ripe, with a generous core of fruit flavours, an open-knit, plush texture and warm baking spice details on the finish.

Cote de Beaune Villages, Louis Latour £34.95

France, 12.5%

Exhibiting typical Pinot Noir characteristics, this wine is light brick red in colour. The nose is characterized by pronounced cherry stone nuances. Côte de Beaune Villages is fresh and balanced, with abundant red fruits and a finale offering hints of menthol. Good length on the palate, a significant aromatic presence and balanced tannins. A very charming wine.
